IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF AQUA NEW JERSEY, INC. FOR APPROVAL OF A MUNICIPAL CONSENT TO PROVIDE WASTEWATER SERVICE TO A PORTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON AND OTHER REQUIRED APPROVALS

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES:

Petitioner, Aqua New Jersey, Inc., a public utility corporation of the State of New Jersey, having its principal office at 10 Black Forest Road, Hamilton, New Jersey 08691 (hereinafter referred to as the "Company" or "Aqua"), respectfully submits this Petition pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:2-14 and N.J.A.C. 14:1-5.5 and shows that:

1. Aqua is engaged in the business of collecting, treating and distributing water for retail service to approximately 55,000 customers, and providing retail wastewater service to approximately 6,600 customers. With respect to wastewater service, the Company collects wastewater effluent and conveys it to treatment facilities from which Aqua purchases wastewater treatment services. The Company's water and wastewater customers are located in several municipalities in Warren, Hunterdon, Mercer, Burlington, Monmouth, Camden, Ocean, Sussex and Gloucester Counties, New Jersey. The Company has organized its business by the following Divisions: Northern Division (based in Phillipsburg), Central Division (based in Hamilton), Eastern Division (based in Berkeley) and the Southern Division (based in Blackwood).

2. For the last few years, Aqua has been in discussions with the Township of Harrison (the "Township"), County of Gloucester, regarding authority to provide wastewater service within a limited area of the Township.

3. On September 18, 2023, the Township enacted an Ordinance (Ordinance No. 18-2023) which grants to the Company a franchise to maintain, repair, replace and operate wastewater facilities, and provide wastewater service to a portion of the Township identified on Exhibit A to the Ordinance (the "Franchise Area"). A copy of the Ordinance is attached to this Petition as Attachment 1. Under the terms of the municipal consent, the Company is authorized to maintain, repair, replace and operate wastewater service facilities within the Franchise Area for the purpose of providing wastewater service to the Franchise Area. As noted above, a map depicting the Franchise Area is attached to the Ordinance as Exhibit A.

4. The proposed Franchise Area is partially developed and abuts a portion of the State Route 322 corridor which has been identified for further residential and commercial development. Currently, there is no public sewer service in the Franchise Area. To the extent wastewater service is available in the proposed Franchise Area, it is provided by private septic systems and cesspools. Elsewhere in the Township, wastewater service is provided by the municipality,¹ but the Township does not have the resources necessary to provide public wastewater service to the proposed Franchise Area. Aqua, however, provides wastewater service to several nearby communities including Woolwich Township, which is directly adjacent to the proposed Franchise Area.

5. Aqua's intention is to provide service to the proposed Franchise Area via an interconnection with its existing facilities in Woolwich Township. Initially, Aqua will serve a commercial facility along State Route 322. The facilities needed to provide wastewater service will be installed by the developer of the commercial facility and contributed to Aqua.² With respect to existing premises in the proposed Franchise Area, those homes and buildings may

connect to Aqua's wastewater facilities but they will not be required to do so. Aqua has procured wastewater treatment services from the Gloucester County Utilities Authority.

6. Upon installation of any required wastewater facilities, Aqua proposes to provide wastewater service to customers located in the Franchise Area at its then Board-approved rates, including any purchased sewerage treatment adjustment clause then in effect, effective as of the time wastewater service commences. It is the intention of the Company that the system will be included in, and served by, the Company's Southern Division, located in Blackwood.

7. Approval of Aqua's request in this matter is in the public interest and will not have any adverse consequences on the wastewater service currently provided to customers. Aqua will be able to bring significant financial, technical and managerial resources to bear in serving customers located in the Township. Moreover, given the location of the Franchise Area, it would be costly for the Township to construct wastewater facilities to service this portion of the Township. Approval of the Franchise grant will allow Aqua to provide service to customers without incurring the expense and disruption of a significant main extension project. Further, because the required facilities will be contributed, there should be no rate impact on existing customers. Indeed, over time Aqua expects the proposed franchise expansion to be beneficial to existing customers.
